
Dear Mr. Tribble:

I received two memoranda from you dated December 11, 1990 notifying all parties of record that certain communications were received by members of the Commission on November 6, 1990, and November 20, 1990. The document dated November 6 appears to be prefiled testimony, complete with numbered lines, a question and answer format, and an attached exhibit showing qualifications of the witness. Formal evidentiary hearings were held on November 28 and 29. Your memoranda do not state why you are distributing copies of the communications after the evidentiary hearings were held, nor why you are distributing them more than fifteen days after they were received by the Commission.
