The Staff of the Florida Public Service Commission ("Staff") has issued its First Request for Production in the above-captioned docket, requesting that Southern Bell furnish, in response to Item No. 15, a copy of the General Ledger for 1991.

Some of the information contained in the General Ledger is clearly proprietary. The ledger contains data on non-regulated activities as well as regulated. Any competitor or potential competitor of Southern Bell's non-regulated services would desire this information to allow the targeting of lucrative markets. If this were to occur, Southern Bell's revenues could well be diminished with the resulting shortfall which would work to the ultimate detriment of Southern Bell's ratepayers.



Pursuant to Rule 25-22.034, Florida Administrative code, and Rule 1.350, Florida Rules of Civil Procedure, the Staff of the Florida Public Service Commission, by and through its undersigned attorney, hereby serves the following Request for Production of Documents upon BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., d/b/a Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company.

Please produce the following documents at the Florida Public Service Commission, 101 East Gaines Street, Room 226, Fletcher Building, Tallahassee, Florida, no later than thirty days after service of this request for the purpose of inspection and copying.

DEFINITIONS

As used herein, the word "documents" shall mean the original and any non-identical copies of any writing or record, including but not limited to a book, pamphlet, periodical, letter, memorandum, telegram, report, study, interoffice or intraoffice, handwritten or other notes, working paper, draft, application, permit, chart, paper, graph, survey, index, tape, disc, data sheet or data processing card, computer printout, or any other written,

recorded, transcribed, filed or graphic matter, however produced or reproduced.

DOCUMENTS REQUESTED

1. Provide all workpapers which contain detailed calculations supporting the rate base, capital structure, and NOI adjustments.
2. Provide all workpapers which contain detailed calculations supporting all proforma adjustments.
3. Provide a list of all responsibility cost centers and a brief description of each code. These centers should not be limited to Southern Bell, but should include all cost centers whereby costs are allocated to Southern Bell.
4. Provide descriptions as to how these responsibility cost centers translate the financial data into primary accounts.
5. Provide the most current Function Code manual.
6. Provide the most current budget manual.

7. Provide the 1992 and 1993 budgets.
8. List all assumptions used in budgeting the 1992 and 1993 year.
9. Complete the attached schedules A through I which detail charges from BellSouth and affiliates to Southern Bell.
10. Provide management and executive incentive compensation plan manual.
11. Provide the workpapers that calculate the Universal Service Fund (USF) amount for 1991, 1992, and 1993.
12. Provide the worksheets submitted to the National Exchange Carrier Association (NECA) for 1991 and 1992.
13. Provide the ARMIS data, consisting of reports 43-02, 43-03, and 43-04, that are filed with the FCC, for 1991.
14. Provide a current copy of the Chart of Accounts, and a brief description of each account.

15. Provide a copy of the regulated General Ledger for for the year ending December 31, 1991.
