Dear Sir:

This is in reply to your letter of December 8, 1976 regarding service to Mr. Emory Robinson, Jr. at 7058 Utsey Road.

We first furnished service to this building in 1962 pursuant to all legal requirements existing at that time. Subsequently, the member upgraded this service to three-phase as evidenced by temporary Electrical Permit No. 6147 dated May 10, 1973, followed by permanent Electrical Permit No. 8301 dated June 30, 1973. At that time the member elected to receive service at single-phase. Recently, he elected to take service at three-phase and we agreed to supply it, which we have a perfect right to do.

It is abundantly clear to us that had the member elected to take three-phase service at the time the service was installed, and we had agreed to supply it, there would have been no protest from you. Your protest at this time is unwarranted and unreasonable and is further evidence of the concerted and deliberate effort, put forth rigorously in the last couple of years by JEA to put us out of business in Duval County or, at least, to prevent us from expanding.

It is our intention to continue to serve in Duval County, including upgraded services. Harmonious relations between our organizations would be considerably enhanced if you would accept the basic concept that Okfenoke serves in Duval County as a right and not as a privilege granted by JEA.

We agree that the customer should not be inconvenienced and we sincerely trust that our refusal to disconnect his service will not be used as sufficient reason for him to be harrassed by any agency of Duval County who may have the power to do so.
