Reference is made to that letter dated June 29, 1992 notifying you that SunCoast Pipeline Company, a proposed Texas General Partnership, would be filing an application with your Bureau for a Determination of Need for an Intrastate Natural Gas Transmission Pipeline pursuant to Section 403.9422(2)(b) of the Florida Statutes. The purpose of this letter is to advise you that the proposed SunCoast partnership did not come into being and therefore SunCoast will not be pursuing an Application for Determination of Need as stated in the foregoing letter. In its stead, SunShine Pipeline Company will be filing such an application with your Bureau on or before October 1, 1992.

SunShine will own and operate an intrastate natural gas natural gas transmission pipeline in the State of Florida. As currently proposed, the SunShine system will originate at a point near the Oklaloosa-Walton County Line boundary and will extend east and south ultimately terminating near Florida Power & Light's Martin County Electric Power Generation Unit. It is also proposed that lateral lines will extend off the SunShine mainline system, to wit: in Leon County to the city of Tallahassee; in Lake County to the City of Leesburg; from a point in Sumter County to a point in Tarpon Springs, Pinellas County; and from a point in Polk County to a point in Hillsborough County.
