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PETITION OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA TO INTERVENE

Pursuant to Rule 25-22.039, Florida Administrative Code, the Attorney General of the State of Florida, Robert A. Butterworth ("Attorney General"), by and through his undersigned counsel, hereby files his Petition to Intervene in the above-captioned proceeding. In support thereof, the Attorney General states as follows:

1. The Attorney General is the chief state legal officer¹ and has authority to appear in all suits in which the state may be interested.² As the chief state legal officer, the Attorney General is the head of the Department of Legal Affairs.

2. The Attorney General was a party to this docket's predecessor (Docket No. 880069) and with Jack Shreve, the Public Counsel, and the American Association of Retired Persons jointly filed a Joint Petition For The Immediate Refund Of Accumulated Overcharges; For The Immediate Reduction Of The Current Rates Of Southern Bell; For The Reduction Of Permanent Rates Of Southern


