On Friday August 21, 1992, the Office of Public Counsel (OPC) filed a Petition for Full Commission Assignment, pursuant to Section 350.01(6), Florida Statutes. The statute requires that the full Commission dispose of this Petition within 15 days of receipt. The next available agenda within fifteen days is the September 1, 1992, Agenda.
