SOUTHERN BELL TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY'S MOTION FOR A TEMPORARY PROTECTIVE ORDER FOR ITS RESPONSE TO PUBLIC COUNSEL'S FIFTEENTH SET OF INTERROGATORIES, ITEM NOS. 367 AND 370

COMES NOW, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a Southern
Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company ("Southern Bell" or "Company"),
and files pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(5)(c), Florida Administrative
Code, its Motion for Temporary Protective Order.

- 1. On October 8, 1992, the Office of Public Counsel ("Public Counsel") served upon Southern Bell its Fifteenth Set of Interrogatories. Within that set of Interrogatories are Item Nos. 367 and 370, which request information regarding certain proprietary development and concept field trials of a competitive nature. Southern Bell considers this information to be proprietary and confidential business information pursuant to § 364.183, Florida Statutes.
- 2. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(5)(c), Florida Administrative Code, Southern Bell moves the Prehearing Officer to issue a Temporary Protective Order exempting the portions of the Company's responses to the above-referenced Interrogatories from § 119.07(1), Florida Statutes.

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- 3. If Public Counsel subsequently notifies Southern Bell that this proprietary information is to be used in a proceeding before this Commission, Southern Bell will, in accordance with Rule 25-22.006(5)(c), Florida Administrative Code, file a detailed Motion for Protective Order specifically addressing the information identified.
- 4. With respect to Southern Bell's responses to Item Nos. 367 and 370, the information requested pertains to current software development and concept field trial work being conducted by Southern Bell. This information relates to Southern Bell's competitive interests and also specifically discloses vendor-specific information. Such information is expressly exempt from the public inspection and examination provision of § 119.07(1), Florida Statutes pursuant to § 364.183(3)(d) and (e), Florida Statutes.
- 5. All of the information for which Southern Bell requests confidential treatment is intended to be treated as confidential, has been treated as confidential and has not been disclosed to any third party except pursuant to statutory provisions or private agreement that provides that the information will not be released to the public.

WHEREFORE, Southern Bell respectfully requests that the Prehearing Officer issue a Temporary Protective Order exempting portions of Southern Bell's responses to Item Nos. 367 and 370 of Public Counsel's Fifteenth Set of Interrogatories from § 119.97(1), Florida Statutes, in accordance with Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code.
