Dear Sebring Utilities Customer:

The Sebring Utilities Commission (Sebring) and the City of Sebring have agreed to sell the Sebring electric system to Florida Power Corporation. The sale is contingent upon the approval of the Florida Public Service Commission (FPSC). If this transaction is approved, it is anticipated that you will experience lower electric rates. The purpose of this letter is to notify you of the proposed sale and the review process currently underway at the FPSC, and to tell you where you can obtain more information on the proposed rate changes.

A public hearing will be held at the FPSC, Fletcher Building, 101 East Gaines Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0850, on December 7 and 8, 1992, to address the Joint Petition of Florida Power and Sebring for approval of this transaction. The key dates in this proceeding are as follows:

October 20

Filing of intervenor and Commission staff written testimony

November 23

Prehearing conference

December 7, 8

Hearing

December 18

Final written order

Copies of the Joint Petition, and the testimony and evidence filed in support of the petition, are on public file at the FPSC offices in Tallahassee.

As part of the Joint Petition, Florida Power and Sebring have asked the FPSC to approve an amendment to the existing territorial agreement to allow Florida Power to operate an electric system in territory previously allocated to Sebring. In addition, the two utilities have asked the FPSC to approve a supplemental rider rate, to be added to Florida Power's normal rates for up to 15 years, in order to recover the funds necessary to retire Sebring's debt.

The Joint Petition and details concerning the savings that are estimated to flow to Sebring customers as a result of the new Florida Power rates and the supplemental rider rate, are on file at Sebring's main office at 321 Mango Street, Sebring (385-0191), and Florida Power's Avon Park office at 600 West Main Street, Avon Park (453-3157). Should you have questions or comments regarding the proposed sale of the Sebring system or the rates that are expected to result from the sale, please contact either of these offices.


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








RESIDENTIAL Rate Comparison








GENERAL SERVICE NON-DEMAND Rate Comparison



☐ Sebring Utilities Commission Inside City Limits






Monthly kWh | Sebring Utilities Commission Outside City Limits | Florida Power Corporation Outside City Limits
