Issue 1: Recommendation that the Commission recognize 1991 earnings in excess of the 14.40% maximum authorized ROE of \$435,636 as a final settlement of Northeast's 1991 earnings. The utility should refund the \$435,636 plus ~~\$31,724~~ in interest accrued through December 31, 1992, for a total of ~~\$467,360~~, in accordance with the provisions of the settlement agreement accepted by the Commission.
