COMES NOW BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., d/b/a Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company ("Southern Bell" or "Company"), and hereby files pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, its Notice of Intent to Seek Confidential Classification, and states as grounds in support thereof the following:

During a panel deposition held on June 18 and 19, 1992,
 Public Counsel requested production of certain documents and the

provision of certain information. The parties agreed to a procedure whereby these documents and this information would be provided without the necessity of a formal request to produce and/or formal interrogatories. Specifically, there was an agreement that this information would be produced at a subsequent date as "Late Filed Exhibits" to the depositions.

- 2. Some of the information contained therein was confidential business information that is exempt from the public disclosure requirements of Florida Statutes § 119.07.

 Specifically, Late Filed Exhibit No. 47 to this deposition contains proprietary information that, if disclosed, will result in a breach of the security of the Southern Bell computer system. Accordingly, at the time that Southern Bell produced this information to Public Counsel (August 7, 1992), it filed a Motion for Temporary Protective Order.
