PURPOSE AND PROCEDURE
The purpose of this hearing will be to take evidence to determine the need, pursuant to Section 403,9422, Florida Statutes, for the construction and operation of a proposed intrastate natural gas pipeline in Florida. The plipeline would originate at a point in Chalcosa County and extend east and south through the following counties: Dixie, Gadden, Glichria, Hardes, Flermando, Highlands, Holmes, Jackson, Jefferson, Lake, Leon, Levy, Madison, Marion, Okalcosa, Okeechobee, Pasco, Pinellas, Polk, Sumer, Taylor, Walton, and Washington.

Initially the pipeline will consist of approximately five hundred two (502) miles of mainline and laterials, having a capacity of \$20,000 Mcf (thousand cubic feet) per day which will be operated without compression during the first three years of service, scheduled to commence in February, 1995.
