TO REQUEST CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

COMES NOW BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company ("Southern Bell" or "Company") and files, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, this Withdrawal of its Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification.

1. On March 5, 1993, the Office of the Attorney General ("Attorney General") distributed a list of witness statements to the parties in these dockets. Southern Bell was subsequently informed that the Attorney General had delivered the actual statements themselves to the Staff of the Commission. On March 8, 1993, Southern Bell filed a Notice of Intent to Request Confidential


Classification because it believed that it should be given an opportunity to review these statements for proprietary confidential information prior to public release of the statements.

2. On March 8, 1993, the Attorney General released to the public the statements at issue. This was done prior to a determination by the Prehearing Officer as to whether the statements contained proprietary confidential information. Since this material has been released to the public, Southern Bell's Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification has been rendered moot. Accordingly, Southern Bell hereby withdraws its Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification.

WHEREFORE, Southern Bell respectfully requests that Southern Bell's Withdrawal of its Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification be accepted in accordance with Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code.
