COMES NOW, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company ("Southern Bell" or "Company"), and files, pursuant to Rule 25-22.034, Florida Administrative Code, and Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), its Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification.

BACKGROUND

- 1. On January 7, 1993, the Florida Public Service Commission Staff ("Staff") participated in the deposition of Nancy Sims, an employee of Southern Bell. At the deposition, Staff requested several late filed exhibits. Subsequent to the provision of those exhibits to Staff by Southern Bell, Staff requested a supplement to Late Filed Exhibit No. 6.
- Southern Bell's Supplemental Response to Sims Late Filed 2. proprietary confidential Exhibit No. 6 is entitled to classification because it contains the numerical distribution of Southern Bell's intraLATA toll messages by mileage band, broken down by business, residence, public and "other" categories. Consequently, this information discloses usage patterns for certain classes of Southern Bell customers and shows the representative mileage for intraLATA calls made by these customers. Since the intraLATA toll market is a competitive arena, competitors could use

this information to selectively target their marketing strategies and pricing to appeal to key customer bases, thereby depriving Southern Bell of valuable opportunities to provide service to the customers in its service areas. Section 364.183(e), Florida Statutes, expressly considers as proprietary confidential business information any information relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider. The information contained in Southern Bell's Supplemental Response to Sims Late Filed Exhibit No. 6 meets the statutory criteria, and should therefore be afforded confidential classification.
