**SOUTHERN BELL TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY'S  
SECOND MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

COMES NOW BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., d/b/a Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company ("Southern Bell" or "Company"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.037, Florida Administrative Code, and hereby moves the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") for a second thirty-day extension of time in which to file a traffic study in response to Order No. PSC-93-0029-PCO-TL, entered in the above-referenced docket, and states as grounds in support thereof the following:

1. On January 6, 1993, this Commission issued Order No. PSC-93-0029-PCO-TL, which directed Southern Bell to prepare and submit within 90 days a traffic study of the routes between all exchanges in Palm Beach County. Thus, under the Order, the required traffic study was due on or before April 6, 1993. Prior to the expiration of the time for filing the study, Southern Bell requested a thirty-day extension of time. The reason for this

request was that the unusual complexity of the required study was such that it could likely not have been completed by April 6, 1993. Accordingly, a thirty-day extension was requested, until May 6, 1993.

2. Within the past thirty days, Southern Bell completed the study as directed. The results of the study, however, are such that it appears that the study is not valid. In other words, the data that the study produced appears on its face to be inaccurate.

3. Accordingly, Southern Bell requires additional time to determine the cause of the problem that resulted in these apparently invalid results, to correct the problem, and to conduct a new study that will yield accurate information. Southern Bell believes that an additional period of thirty days will be adequate for it to accomplish these tasks.

4. The requested additional extension will not prejudice any party to this proceeding. Further, it will allow Southern Bell adequate time to provide this Commission with the information necessary to reach an informed decision in this matter.

WHEREFORE, Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company respectfully requests that this Commission grant it a second

thirty-day extension, until June 5, 1993, in which to respond to  
Order No. PSC-93-0029-PCO-TL.
