MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE TRAFFIC STUDY

United Telephone Company of Florida (United) moves the Florida Public Service Commission to grant United an extension of time to file its traffic study in this Docket, and as grounds therefore states:

- 1. Florida Public Service Commission Order No. PSC-93-0512-PCO-TL was issued in this Docket on April 5, 1993, and required traffic studies be submitted by ALLTEL Florida, Inc., BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company and United. The Order directed that such studies be filled within ninety days of the date of the Order.
- 2. During the same general time period the Order described in paragraph 1 above was issued, United was also ordered to provide traffic studies by Order No. PSC-93-0464-PCO-TL, issued March 26, 1993, in Docket No. 930234-TL (Mount Dora), Order No. PSC-93-0416-PCO-TL, issued March 17, 1993 in Docket No. 930172-TL (Boca Grande) and Order No. PSC-93-0437-PCO-TL, issued March 23, 1993, in Docket No. 931073-TL (Haines City).
- 3. The Marion County traffic study requires United to study 117 individual routes. Five exchanges and two other companies are involved, and three pocket areas must be coordinated between the companies involved. It is estimated that as many as 200 data runs will be required to complete the study. This is among the largest traffic studies ever requested from United. The work required by this study, plus the work

required by the Mount Dora, Boca Grande and Haines City studies has overwhelmed the United Study Group.

4. United requests that it be granted an extension of time to and including September 5, 1993, to file its traffic study in this Docket. This is an extension of sixty days. United will use its best efforts to complete the study as soon as possible, but realistically does not believe it can complete the study before September 5, 1993.

WHEREFORE, United requests that it be granted to and including September 5, 1993 to file its traffic study in this Docket.
