**SOUTHERN BELL TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY'S  
MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

COMES NOW BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., d/b/a/  
Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company ("Southern Bell" or  
"Company"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.037, Florida Administrative  
Code, and hereby moves the Florida Public Service Commission  
("the Commission") for a thirty-day extension of time in which to  
respond to Order No. PSC-93-0512-PCO-TL in the above-referenced  
docket, and states as grounds in support thereof:

1. On April 5, 1993, the Commission issued Order No. PSC-  
93-0512-PCO-TL, which requires Southern Bell to file traffic  
studies on approximately forty routes in Marion County.

Specifically, the Southern Bell routes for which traffic studies  
have been ordered are those that are listed on Schedule III of  
the Order and that originate in Dunnellon, Micanopy and Micanopy  
(pocket).

2. Southern Bell has performed the traffic study as  
ordered. The results of the traffic study, however, are such  
that they appear to be partially in error. The traffic study on  
the fifteen Southern Bell routes originating in Micanopy (pocket)  
reflect differing numbers of subscribers in this area. In other  
words, the study results for some routes reflect one number of

subscribers in the Micanopy pocket, while the study results for other routes reflect a different number of subscribers in this pocket. This facial conflict appears to reflect an as yet unidentified error in the study.

3. Southern Bell requires an additional 30 days to determine the cause of the error relating to these fifteen routes and to remedy the problem. The requested extension will not prejudice any party to this proceeding and will provide information regarding these routes that will facilitate a reasoned, informed decision by this Commission.

WHEREFORE, Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company respectfully requests that the Commission grant it a thirty-day day extension, until August 4, 1993, in which to respond to Order No. PSC-93-0512-PCO-TL by providing the traffic study of the required routes.
