MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE

The Florida Waterworks Association, by and through its undersigned counsel, and with the support of Southern States Utilities, Inc., requests that the Commission cancel and reschedule the resumption of the hearings in this docket from July 14-16, 1993 to a date no earlier than 30 days thereafter, and in support states the following:

1. At the close of business on July 8, 1993, the Association obtained a copy of an exhibit and other materials prepared by PSC Staff regarding proposed Rule 25-30.432.

2. The thrust of this massive Staff filing appears to be to propose lowering by more than half certain factors employed in the used and useful default formulas under consideration.

3. There is insufficient information presented in the Staff filing to allow the Association and Southern States Utilities, Inc. to evaluate the rationale and impact of this newest Staff proposal on the proposed rules.


4. There is insufficient time available before resumption of the hearing on July 14, 1993 for the Association and Southern States Utilities, Inc. to analyze the newest Staff proposal, to discuss it with Staff so as to adequately understand the assumptions and rationale used, and to otherwise have an adequate opportunity to respond and to present evidence and argument. No less than 30 days would be required for such preparation.

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PSC-REGISTRATION

5. Representatives of the Association and Southern States Utilities, Inc. are travelling from diverse points around and outside of the State of Florida to participate at the hearing. We therefore requests that the Commission's disposition of the motion be made and communicated to counsel as soon as possible and in any event by mid-day, Tuesday, July 13, 1993, the day before the hearing.

Based on the foregoing, the Florida Waterworks Association, with the support of Southern States Utilities, Inc., requests that a 30-day (or greater) continuance of the resumption of the hearing be granted, and that said action be taken and communicated to its counsel by mid-day, Tuesday, July 13, 1993.
