On October 30, 1992, the Florida Cable Television Association (FCTA) filed a Motion to Dismiss Southern Bell's Petition for Order Adopting Plan for Alternative Method of Regulation (Motion) in the above-referenced docket. Southern Bell filed its Response to FCTA's Motion on November 12, 1992.

As you will recall, during the series of five prehearing conferences held during January and February of this year, the Prehearing Officer determined that FCTA's Motion would be heard by the full Commission as part of the scheduled hearings in this docket.

On July 2, 1993, Southern Bell filed a Petition for Extension of Current Incentive Sharing Plan (Petition). As part of its current Petition, Southern Bell has withdrawn its previous Petition. Accordingly, FCTA's Motion is now moot. As such, no ruling will be rendered on FCTA's Motion.


