ORDER AMENDING CERTIFICATES TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL TERRITORY AND CLOSING DOCKET

BY THE COMMISSION:

On April 29, 1993, Southern States Utilities, Inc. (SSU or utility) filed an application with this Commission to amend Certificates Nos. 76-W and 284-S to include additional territory, which it is already serving, in Putnam County, Florida. The proposed extensions are to the utility's six current water and wastewater systems in Putnam County: Beecher's Point, Interlachen Lake Estates, Palm Port, River Park, Saratoga Harbor and Wootens.

SSU's proposed amendments are in a critical use area as defined by the St. Johns River Water Management District. The six developments have small water plants which provide water service to customers in Putnam County. Additionally, the Palm Port system provides wastewater service to customers in the Palm Port development. The Palm Port wastewater plant capacity is 50,000 gallons per day (gpd). Currently, the wastewater system is not sized to provide reclaimed water, however should the utility flows reach 100,000 gpd, reuse requirement should then be addressed. The amendment is consistent with the Putnam County Comprehensive Plan and there will be no additional water or wastewater facilities built to serve the proposed territory. Service will be provided by extending existing transmission and distribution lines.

Since SSU is already serving the area, it is in violation of Section 367.045(2), Florida Statutes, which requires a utility to obtain Commission approval prior to extending its service area.

Docket No. 921014-WS was opened to address areas which SSU serves outside of its certificated territory in violation of Section 367.045(2), Florida Statutes. Order No. PSC-93-0202-FOF-WS, issued February 9, 1993 in that Docket, approved a timetable for SSU to follow in filing applications for amendments to include the territory being served outside of its service area. SSU provided an explanation for its actions and the Commission

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determined that if the utility complied with the Order and followed the timetable for filing the amendment applications addressed in Docket No. 921014-WS, show cause proceedings would not be initiated and the amendment applications could be processed administratively.

Application

The application is in compliance with Section 367.045, Florida Statutes, and other pertinent statutes and administrative rules. The application contains a check in the amount of \$300.00 which is the correct filing fee pursuant to Rule 25-30.020, Florida Administrative Code. In addition, SSU provided evidence, in the form of a warranty deed, that the utility owns the land upon which the utility's facilities are located as required by Rule 25-30.036(1)(d), Florida Administrative Code.

Adequate service territory and system maps and a territory description have been provided as prescribed by Rule 25-30.036, Florida Administrative Code. Descriptions of the territory requested by the utility are appended to this Order in Attachments A and B.

In addition, the application contains proof of compliance with the noticing provisions set forth in Rule 25-30.030, Florida Administrative Code. On May 18, 1993, we received a customer objection to the amendment application. On July 19, 1993, the customer formally withdrew her objection by letter.

Presently, SSU provides quality water and wastewater service to the residents of Putnam County. The utility has the capability and financial resources to adequately service the proposed new territory. The proposed new territory will have no substantial effect on the utility's financial status. The Department of Environmental Protection has reported no outstanding violations for this utility.

Rates and Charges

The utility's existing water and wastewater rates are interim rates and charges which became effective on September 18, 1992, pursuant to Order No. PSC-92-0948-FOF-SU. We find the current rates and charges to be reasonable and they are hereby approved. SSU shall charge these rates and charges to customers in the new service territory until authorized to change by the Commission.

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The utility has filed revised tariff sheets incorporating the additional territory into its tariff and has submitted Certificates Nos. 76-W and 284-S for entry reflecting the additional territory.

Based on the above information, we find that it is in the public interest to grant SSU's application for amendment of Water Certificate No. 76-W and Wastewater Certificate No. 284-S for the territory described in Attachments A and B.

Based on the foregoing, it is, therefore,

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Nos. 76-W and 284-S, held by Southern States Certificates Utilities, Inc., 1000 Color Place, Apopka, Florida, 32703, are hereby amended to include the territories described in attachments A and B of this Order, which by reference are incorporated herein. It is further

ORDERED that Southern States Utilities, Inc., shall charge the customers in the territory added herein the interim rates and charges authorized by Order No. PSC-92-0948-FOF-SU until authorized to change by this Commission. It is further

ORDERED that Docket No. 930443-WS is hereby closed.

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NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 120.59(4), Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any administrative hearing or judicial review of Commission orders that is available under Sections 120.57 or 120.68, Florida Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for an administrative hearing or judicial review will be granted or result in the relief sought.

Any party adversely affected by the Commission's final action in this matter may request: 1) reconsideration of the decision by filing a motion for reconsideration with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting within fifteen (15) days of the issuance of this order in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code; or 2) judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility or the First District Court of Appeal in the case of a water or sewer utility by filing a notice of appeal with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting and filing a copy of the notice of appeal and the filing fee with the appropriate court. This filing must be completed within thirty (30) days after the issuance of this order, pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Civil Procedure. The notice of appeal must be in the form specified in Rule 9.900 (a), Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
