Issue 2: Recommendation that Turkey Creek Utilities should be required to refund all monies collected in excess of the rates and charges approved in Orders Nos. PSC-93-0229-FOF-WS and PSC-93-0816-FOF-WS. The utility should be ordered to pay interest on the refunds, calculated in accordance with Rule 25-30.360, F.A.C., that has accrued or will accrue until the date of refunds. In addition, the refunds should be made on a per customer basis. The refunds should be accomplished within ninety days of the effective date of the order and the utility should be required to file reports consistent with Rule 25-30.360, F.A.C. The periods which the refunds cover should be those outlined in the staff memorandum dated 10/28/93. All unclaimed refunds should be forwarded to the City of Alachua for further disposition.
