

**TAMPA ELECTRIC COMPANY'S
MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

Tampa Electric Company ("Tampa Electric" or "the company") moves the Commission for an extension of time through and including Monday, January 24, 1994, within which to file the company's fuel adjustment petition and supporting testimony and exhibits relative to Tampa Electric's proposed fuel adjustment factor and oil backout ("OBO") cost recovery for the forthcoming cost recovery period, April through September 1994. In support thereof, the company says:

1. Tampa Electric had planned to submit its fuel adjustment and OBO filing this date. However, one day prior to the filing date the company detected a material error in its calculation which, without correction, would materially overstate the fuel adjustment charge. The fuel adjustment error carries over to the OBO schedules but does not affect the generating performance incentive factor ("GPIF") schedules.

2. An extension of time through and including Monday, January 24, 1994, will enable Tampa Electric to revise its fuel adjustment and OBO filings to eliminate the effects of the error. The requested extension of time should not present a problem to any


party and will improve the accuracy of Tampa Electric's fuel adjustment and OBO calculations.

3. The company is filing this date its GPIF testimony and exhibit. Tampa Electric's Petition for approval of its proposed fuel and OBO cost recovery and GPIF true up, targets and ranges will be submitted with the corrected fuel adjustment and OBO data no later than January 24, 1994, and certainly earlier than that date if the work can be completed sooner.

WHEREFORE, Tampa Electric Company moves the Commission for an extension of time through and including January 24, 1994 within which to submit its fuel adjustment and OBO calculations and supporting testimony and exhibits relative to the forthcoming fuel adjustment cost recovery period, April through September 1994.
