PETITION FOR APPROVAL OF
FLORIDA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMPANY'S
PROPOSED FUEL ADJUSTMENT CHARGES

Florida Public Utilities Company ("the Company") hereby petitions the Commission to approve its proposed fuel adjustment factors and amounts as further identified below. In support hereof the Company states:

1) The Company is an electric utility company within the jurisdiction of this Commission. Its principal business address is:

3) Pursuant to the requirements of this docket, the Company has prefiled testimonial and documentary evidence in a manner consistent with Commission Staff's instructions.

4) As detailed in the prefiled testimony and exhibits:

(a) the final remaining fuel adjustment true-up amounts for the period April 1, 1993 through September 30, 1993 are \$87,558

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underrecovery (Marianna) and \$17,891 underrecovery (Fernandina Beach).

(b) the estimated fuel adjustment true-up amounts for the period October 1, 1993 through March, 31, 1994, based upon two months actual and four months estimated data, are \$61,955 overrecovery (Marianna) and \$136,110 overrecovery (Fernandina Beach).

(c) the total true-up amount to be collected in the Marianna Division during the period April 1, 1994 through September 30, 1994 is \$25,603. The total true-up amount to be refunded in the Fernandina Beach Division is \$118,219.

(d) the total fuel adjustment factors (including true-up and revenue tax, but excluding demand cost recovery) for the period April 1, 1994 through September 30, 1994 are 2.754¢ per KWH for the Marianna Division, and 4.521¢ per KWH for the Fernandina Beach Division. The total fuel adjustment factors, including true-up, applicable revenue tax, and demand cost recovery during the period April 1, 1994 through September 30, 1994, for the Marianna Division, adjusted for line loss multipliers, are as follows:

RS	4.839¢/kwh
GS	4.505¢/kwh
GSD	4.082¢/kwh
OL, OL-2	2.789¢/kwh
SL-1, SL-2	2.721¢/kwh


For Fernandina Beach the factors after adjustment for line loss multipliers are as follows:

<u>Rate Schedule</u>	<u>Adjustment</u>
RS	5.852¢/kwh
GS	5.608¢/kwh
GSD	5.434¢/kwh
OL, SL, CSL	4.898¢/kwh

WHEREFORE, the Company respectfully requests that this Commission enter its order approving the above total fuel adjustment factors to be applied to billings for the months April 1, 1993 through September 30, 1994 and to billings thereafter until other cost recovery factors are approved by the Commission.
