RE: DOCKET NO. 931020-WS - Application for transfer of Certificates Nos. 552-W and 481-S in Marion County from THE RESOLUTION TRUST CORPORATION to C.F.A.T. H20, INC.

Issue 1: Recommendation that the transfer of Certificates Nos. 552-W and 481-S from the Resolution Trust Corporation to C.F.A.T. H20, Inc. be approved. In addition, C.F.A.T. H20, Inc. should be required to file a recorded warranty deed or other proof of ownership within 30 days of closing.

APPROVED

Issue 2: Recommendation that the rate base, which for transfer purposes reflects the net book value, be established as \$5,504 for the water system and \$2,950 for the wastewater system as of December 31, 1993. Also, the utility should be required to restate those accounts as described in staff's memorandum dated 5/5/94 to conform with Commission Order No. PSC-93-0900-POF-WS, issued June 14, 1993 and conform with NARUC rules.




