NOTICE OF INTENT TO REQUEST CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

Gulf Power Company, by and through its undersigned attorney and pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), Florida Administrative Code, hereby gives notice that it intends to request confidential classification for certain information requested by the Florida Public Service Commission Staff in the above-referenced matter. A copy of Staff's Third Set of Interrogatories to Gulf Power Company (No. 44) is attached hereto as exhibit "A", and requests, in pertinent part, actual 12 month kWh, maximum metered demand, and annual load factor, for Gulf's Standby Service ("SBS") customers, and certain other customers on a customer-specific basis. It is also anticipated that this information may be used by Staff during the deposition of Gulf Power witness James I. Thompson on July 22, 1994.

The information described above is considered by our customers to be proprietary and confidential, and release thereof will impair the competitive business interests of these customers. In fact, certain of Gulf's customers have advised the Company that they strongly oppose public disclosure of this information.




