INDUSTRIAL INTERVENORS' JOINDER IN GULF POWER COMPANY'S  
SUPPLEMENTAL REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

Monsanto Company, Stone Container Corporation, and Champion International, Inc. (Industrial Intervenors), by and through their undersigned counsel, join Gulf Power Company (Gulf Power) in its request that the Florida Public Service Commission (Commission) enter an order protecting certain additional information, submitted in response to a data request regarding Late-filed Exhibit No. 14, from public disclosure. In support, Industrial Intervenors state:

1. On August 30, 1994, Gulf Power filed a formal request for confidential classification as to Late-filed Exhibit No. 14, pursuant to rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code. On September 8, 1994, Industrial Intervenors filed a joinder to Gulf Power's request for confidential classification.

2. Following the submission of Late-filed Exhibit No. 14, Commission Staff requested that the information contained within that exhibit be recalculated utilizing a different data component. Because the information contained in the recalculation is identical to that found in Late-filed Exhibit No. 14, Gulf Power submitted a supplemental request for confidential classification on September 16, 1994.

3. The information contained in the recalculation consists of data regarding individual standby customers' costs of power and consumption patterns. The disclosure of this information may harm the competitive posture of the customers in the highly competitive markets for their products by giving competitors insight into production costs. The information for which the confidential classification is sought has been treated as private and has not been disclosed by Industrial Intervenors. This information, qualifying as proprietary, confidential business information within the meaning of section 366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes, is entitled to confidential treatment.

WHEREFORE, Industrial Intervenors join in Gulf Power Company's request for confidential classification and request that the Commission enter an order protecting the customer-specific information contained in the recalculation of data regarding Late-filed Exhibit No. 14 from public disclosure as proprietary, confidential business information.
