On November 14, 1994, this Commission received an application from Palm Christian Academy for a non-jurisdictional finding pursuant to Section 367.021(12), Florida Statutes. The application was signed by Mr. Albert A. Avedikian, the Owner. The primary contact person for Palm Christian Academy is Pastor Sloan, the Pastor for Palm Tabernacle Church of God and Palm Christian Academy. Pastor Sloan's address is 848 Tamiami Trail, Port Charlotte, Florida, 33954. The applicant, which is a school, currently receives water from its own water treatment plant. The church and school are located in the same building, but all restrooms and drinking fountains are located in the school portion of the building. The school is the only building which receives water from the water treatment plant. Wastewater service is provided by three septic tanks. The physical and mailing addresses of the system are the same as the address shown above for Pastor Sloan.

As stated above, the application was filed in accordance with Section 367.021(12), Florida Statutes, and Rules 25-30.060(1), (2), and (3)(j), Florida Administrative Code. The applicant stated in their application that services will be provided to the business property solely, without compensation, and that all costs for providing such service will be recovered as operational expenses. Furthermore, Mr. Avedikian acknowledged Section 837.06, Florida Statutes, regarding false statements.

According to Section 2.08 (C) (14), Administrative Procedures Manual, Staff has been given administrative authority to approve clear-cut or non-controversial requests for determination of exempt status. Staff recommends that an administrative order be issued as soon as possible finding Palm Christian Academy exempt from Commission regulation pursuant to Section 367.021(12), Florida Statutes. Staff also recommends that the order require Palm Christian Academy to notify this Commission in the event of any
