EG _____ within two years of the March 22, 1993 order. SSU has not filed by
BN _____ March 22, 1995, and has instead requested an extension until the
_____ end of June.

EC _____ The Marco Island system's rate case was addressed in a
CH _____ separate docket (Docket No. 920655-WS). According to the final
EC / _____ order in that case, you, the Office of Public Counsel, SSU and the
AS _____ Commission Staff agreed that the utility would file a service
TH _____ availability case for the Marco Island system within two years of
_____ the issuance of the order. However, as the order in that case was
_____ issued July 23, 1993, SSU has until July 23, 1995 to file for the


