 RE: Request for Confidentiality

In a May 15th meeting with Staff, Electric Fuels Corporation (EFC) presented a report from the Audit Services Department of Florida Power Corporation (FPC) which summarized the results of a comparison of EFC's revenue requirements under full regulatory treatment to revenue requirements using the short-cut method. EFC also presented documents concerning the Waterways User Tax. Staff requested to review these documents as a part of normal discovery in the Fuel docket, 950001-EI. In order to avoid having the documents filed as confidential, Florida Power Corporation filed a copy of the documents under a Notice of Intent to Seek Confidential Classification. This allowed Staff to review the documents for a period of 21 days without requiring FPC to actually request confidential status.

Having sufficiently reviewed the material, Staff requests that Document No. 04936-95 be returned to Florida Power Corporation.
