RE: DOCKET NO. 950737-TP - INVESTIGATION INTO TEMPORARY LOCAL TELEPHONE NUMBER PORTABILITY SOLUTION TO IMPLEMENT COMPETITION IN LOCAL EXCHANGE TELEPHONE MARKETS

Pursuant to Section 364.16(4), Florida Statutes, the Florida Public Service Commission is required to establish a temporary number portability solution by no later than January 1, 1996, if the parties to this proceeding are unable to successfully negotiate the prices, terms, and conditions of a temporary number portability solution.
