I apologize for the delay in responding to your last inquiry regarding our payment intentions. I have spent the time researching several legal issues and I wanted to share with you some concerns.

Given that Turkey Creek, Inc. sold the utility to the City of Alachua before the final opinion was entered, and given that TCI is no longer a "regulated company", we are unsure of the Commission's jurisdiction to collect a penalty or refund. I have found no case law on this subject, although I confess to being a stranger to this area of the law. Accordingly, if you can provide me with the appropriate citations showing continuing jurisdiction over Turkey Creek, Inc., I would be most grateful.
