

Natural Gas Utility Modified Minimum 25-7.041

Filing Requirements Report

PURPOSE AND EFFECT: Section 366.06(3), F.S., which required the Commission to adopt this rule and require the report, was repealed effective July 1, 1995. The report is unnecessary because earnings of gas companies are reviewed on a regular basis through the earnings surveillance program and MMFRs are redundant. Repeal should result in lowering the cost of regulation.

SUMMARY: Rule 25-7.041 required natural gas utilities to file the Modified Minimum Filing Requirement Report every four years and provided the form for that report.
