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I Executive Summary

Audit Purpose: We have applied the procedures described in Section II of this report to audit the appended schedule of fuel costs prepared by an FPSC engineer. The subject of the investigation is the "addition of Natural Gas Unit at University of Florida" by Florida Power Corporation. In particular, the audit work is directed toward determining the causes of unusually high generating costs per KWH for January and September, 1994 and to address whether the utility accounts for the "fair value" of energy produced while testing electric generating units in accordance with Rule 25-6.0144 FAC. The applicable time period is April 1993 through October 1994.

Scope Limitation: Utility waived the need for an audit exit conference. The audit is not based on any confidential information. The last day of field work was August 7, 1995.

Disclaim Public Use: This is an internal accounting report prepared after performing a limited scope audit; accordingly, this document must not be relied upon for any purpose except to assist the Commission staff in the performance of their duties. Substantial additional work would have to be performed to satisfy generally accepted auditing standards and produce audited financial statements for public use.

Opinion: The unusually high generating cost per KWH for January was partially resolved by a revised generation figure. A factor in the unusual generation total was an inconsistant allocation of costs between the capital addition work order and the fuel adjustment clause. This matter should be re-visited in the next fuel audit. The unusual cost per KWH in September was based on incorrect generation figures. Correction of the generation amounts results in a more typical per-KWH generation figure for September. The utility did account for the fair value of energy produced while testing electric generating units according to Rule 255-6.0144 FAC. The expressed opinions extend only to the scope of work described in section II of this report.

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II Audit Scope:

The opinions contained in this report are based on the audit work described below. When used in this report, COMPILED means that audit work includes:

COMPILED - Means that the audit staff reconciled exhibit amounts with the general ledger; visually scanned accounts for error or inconsistency; disclosed any unresolved error, irregularity or inconsistency; and except as otherwise noted performed no other audit work.

Performed analytical review for January through October 1994. Determined a cost per KWH for each. Analyzed "outliers" which fell beyond +/- 1.65 standard deviations from the mean of the per-FWH costs. Obtained utility explanation for the differences.

Read the capital addition work order governing the University of Florida Co-generation project. Determined that testing costs were properly accounted in the work order.

Compiled expenses for January through October 1994. Selectively read unusual journal entries and determined whether they were properly included in the recoverable fuel costs.

Analyzed costs in detail by month. Selected and analyzed journal entries to ascertain that they were properly included in recoverable fuel costs for the indicated months.

Analyzed the utility method of calculation of, and accounting for, "fair value" of energy produced while testing electric generating units. Verified that utility method conformed to Rule 25-6.0144 F.A.C.
