

RESOLUTION 95-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF PENNEY FARMS, FLORIDA REGARDING THE EXTENSION OF LOCAL TELEPHONE TO INCLUDE PALATKA AND KEYSTONE HEIGHTS, FLORIDA.

WHEREAS, telephone service is provided to the Town of Penney Farms, Florida by Southern Bell Company, and

WHEREAS, the Southern Bell Company has petitioned the Florida Public Service Commission to extend the "Local Telephone Service Area" to include the Palatka and Keystone Heights Exchanges, in the Green Cove Springs (Penney Farms) Exchange, and

WHEREAS, the Florida PSC has not granted this extension of the "Local Telephone Service Area", and

WHEREAS, The Town of Penney Farms is an isolated, small, rural municipality without adequate services provided locally and

WHEREAS, some of the residents of the Town of Penney Farms rely on the larger communities of Palatka and Keystone Heights for medical services, legal services, shopping conveniences, employment and other personal and professional needs,


NOW THEREFORE, the Town Council for the Town of Penney Farms, requests the Florida Public Service Commission to reconsider and approve the extension of the Local Telephone Service Area for the Green Cove Springs Exchange to include the Palatka and Keystone Heights Exchanges.
