Dear Ms. Bayo:

On October 10, 1995, Metropolitan Fiber Systems of Florida, Inc. filed with the Florida Public Service Commission a corrected version of the Direct Testimony of Timothy Devine originally filed in Docket No. 950737-TP on September 1, 1995. Along with the corrected version, I sent a letter specifying the particular corrections made, along with appropriate line and page numbers. The line and page numbers to which I referred are the line and page numbers found in the original Devine testimony filed on September 1, 1995, and served on all parties to this proceeding.

The Florida Public Service Commission (and only the Commission) has an intermediate copy (sent after the original but before the October 10, 1995 revisions) which has revised margins and therefore different corresponding line and page numbers than the original version. Please accept the following list of corrections as they would correspond to the intermediate version of Mr. Devine's testimony:

- 1) Page 5, lines 16-18 should now read: "Yes. Metropolitan Fiber Systems of Florida, Inc. was certificated as an Alternative Access Vendor ("AAV") on February 24, 1993.";
- 2) Note deletion of bracketed material on page 7, lines 6-7;


