COMES NOW, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth" or "Company") and files pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(5)(c), Florida Administrative Code, its Ninth Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification ("Notice").

- 1. The Florida Public Service Commission (the "Commission") issued Order No. PSC-95-0034-FOF-TP on January 9, 1995 that directed BellSouth to file expanded interconnection service tariffs for special and switched access services with appropriate cost support. Petitions for reconsideration of the Order were filed, considered and ruled upon in Order No. PSC-95-0680-FOF-TP, issued June 6, 1995.
- 2. Pursuant to the Commission's action, BellSouth is today filing its expanded interconnection service tariffs for both switched and special access services. Accompanying the tariff filing is the appropriate cost data to support BellSouth's filing.
- 3. Some of the data contained in the cost support is considered by BellSouth to be confidential proprietary business information and as such must be protected from disclosure. For example, the data contain specific costs of providing expanded interconnection services in Florida. Disclosure of the data will
