The Applicant is a very small utility which acts merely as a reseller of services purchased in bulk from Manatee County. The Applicant owns only the water distribution facilities within its territory. The Applicant does not own any portion of the sewer treatment facilities or collection facilities serving this territory, all of which are owned, operated and maintained by Manatee County. The Applicant's rates for both water and sewer service are those established by Manatee County in Resolution R-95-219, effective October 1, 1995.

The best territory description and map that is available is attached to the Application and the Tariffs. Our research has failed to reveal any official description of the territory other than by reference to the subdivisions served. It does not appear that the territory has ever been surveyed and the Applicant simply cannot afford that expense. A metes and bounds description has been provided along with the map. The service area is almost entirely built out with only a very few lots remaining to be developed within the subdivisions. No addition to the service area is contemplated for the future.

A single system map has been used, which is based on the system map for the Manatee County sewer system facilities within the service territory. Because of the small size of this utility, no separate water system map has ever been developed.

I appreciate the assistance that your staff members have given me in preparing this filing, particularly the help from Christie Tomlinson and Matilda Sanders. I will be happy to provide any further information that is required. Please feel free to have your staff contact me as necessary.

AGREEMENT FOR FURCHASE OF WATER

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this _____ day of ______. 1967. by and between MANATEE COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "County." and <u>lucess Stored</u> <u>WAISS Countage</u> <u>Lass</u>, whose address is <u>PO Bos 116</u> <u>LOBJER</u> <u>LASS</u>, hereinafter referred to as "Purchaser."

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, County is presently developing a County-wide water system for the purpose of furnishing high quality treated water to all inhabitants of the unincorporated areas of Manatee County, and to suy municipal corporation within Manates County desiring to be served, all in accordance with its authority by Ch. 63-1598, Special Acts of Florida, 1963, and

WHEREAS, Furchaser presently owns and operates a water system having approximately <u>//0</u> connections and is desirous of purchasing water from the County so that it may in turn retail said water to its customers;

NOW THEREFORE in consideration of the mutual covenants and provisions contained herein it is agreed as follows:

from the County all of the potable water which Furchaser shall require for a term of forty (40) years, beginning on or about <u>I. Mirrinbic 1942</u>.

2. The County water system shall be connected to the Purchaser's

water system at the following location: Arthurston 1702, 60' mis' OF 115'ST. Welf O'N NORTH Side OF NONNE mist

Size of Heter Requested:

The County shall pay for the construction of the transmission line leading to the point of connection and Purchaser shall pay for the construction of its transmission line leading from the point of connection. Each party shall be responsible for the maintenance of its own transmission line. 3. County agrees that water to be supplied hereunder will be continuous at all times except that temporary disruption of service at any time caused by an act of God, fire, strikes, casualties, accidents, necessary maintenanço works, breakdowns of or injuries to machinery, pumps, or pipe lines, civil or military authority, insurrection. riot, or any cause beyond its redsonable control, shall not constitute a breach of this Agreement on the part of County, and County shall not be liable to Furchaser or its customers for any damage resulting from such unavoidable disruption of service. County agrees to expeditiously correct any and all disruptions that may occur and restore service within a minimum period of time.

4. All water furnished by County hereunder shall be measured by suitable metering equipment of standard manufacture, to be furnished, installed, maintained, calibrated, and read by County at its own expense, and shall be located at the point of connection identified above. At the written request of Purchaser, County shall inspect and test the meter installed by it in the presence of a representative or representatives of Purchaser. No meter shall be allowed to remain in service which has an error in registration in excess of 2X under normal operating conditions. In the event that a faulty meter is discovered, County shall immediately take steps to restore the meter to an accurate condition or install a new meter at the cost of County.

5. The quantity of water delivered to Purchaser shell be detormined from moter readings made by or on behalf of County approximately once each month, whereupon County agrees to render a bill to Purchaser for the amount then due and payable. Honthly billings shall be made in accordance with standard rate achedule and approved minimum rate as established for Trailer Courts and/or bulk users by formal resolution of the Board of County Commissioners heretofore adopted. Copy of rate achedule in effect as of date of this contract is attached hereto and made a part hereof. The parties hereto agree that the rate may be reasonably revised by County from time to time after duly advertised public hearing. County covenants that the rate it shall charge Purchaser shall in no event exceed the rate that it shall generally charge to other consumers of the same class and category within the County.

Page Two

6. At the time that the tap-in into Furchaser's water system is made, the Furchaser shall pay unto the County the standard tap-in charge and whall make the standard deposit to insure the payment of water bills an set forth by Pesolution buretofore adopted by the Board of County Commissioners. Manatue County, Florida. It is recognized by both parties that the present Wate Resolution of Manates County, Florida, provides that if the meter to be installed is a three (3) inch meter or larger that the tap in charge shall be a matter of special contract between the user and Manates County. If the meter to be installed in this particular transaction is a 3 inch meter or larger, it is bereby agreed that the tap-in charge to be paid by Furchaser to County shall be the actual cost to the County of all material and labor necessary to install anid meter.

7. It is mutually understood and agreed that execution of this Agreement by the respective parties hereto shall not constitute an Agreement between County and any customers of Purchaser. Purchaser agrees to save Gounty hormless from any actions on the part of customers served by Purchaser as a result of disruption of service, failure or any other inndequacy in the water system while operated by Purchaser.

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
