Issue 1: Recommendation that the Office of Public Counsel's motion for reconsideration should be denied because OPC has failed to meet the standard for reconsideration. Order No. PSC-95-1387-PCO-WS does not contain a mistake of fact or law. The Commission should not consider the matter on a de novo basis. Oral argument should not be heard on this motion as it was not requested and is not necessary.
