

Pursuant to Order No. PSC-96-0137-PCO-TP, issued January 31, 1996, United Telephone Company of Florida and Central Telephone Company of Florida ("Sprint-United/Centel" or the "Companies") submit this Report on Issues relating to the MFS Petition.

1. Proposes List of Issues. The Companies propose to use a list of issues identical the one attached to MFS's Petition, dated January 24, 1996. Sprint-United/Centel's Proposed Issues List is attached hereto as Exhibit One and is incorporated herein by reference. This list is also similar to the issues list used by the parties in the Southern Bell portion of this docket.

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
