Dear Ms. Bayo:

Consistent with the provisions of Section 253(a) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, various provisions of Chapter 364, Florida Statutes, and various provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, AT&T Communications of the Southern States, Inc. d/b/a AT&T hereby provides written notice of its intent to provide alternative local exchange telecommunications service in Florida.

AT&T Communications of the Southern States, Inc. d/b/a AT&T (hereinafter "AT&T") is the holder of Alternative Access Vendor Certificate No. 4037, issued by Commission Order No. PSC-95-0619-FOF-TA, entered in Docket No. 950416-TA on May 22, 1995.

Pursuant to Section 364.337(6)(b), Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-24.805(2), Florida Administrative Code, any Alternative Access Vendor certificated prior to July 1, 1995, may become an Alternative Local Exchange Company by filing with the Commission's Division of Records and Reporting a letter of intent to provide local exchange service. Authorization associated with such letter of intent becomes effective January 1, 1996, or upon receipt by the Commission, whichever is later.

AT&T hereby provides the written notice required by Section 364.337(6)(b), Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-24.805(2), Florida Administrative Code, of its intent to provide alternative local exchange telecommunications service in Florida.
