A16.2 PERSONAL PAGING SERVICE (PPS)

A16.2.1 General

- A. Personal Paging Service will allow the subscriber of this service to receive a one-way radio signal that activates a pager when an assigned, conventional seven-digit telephone number is dialed. It is offered in Tone; Tone & Voice; and Tone & Digital Display.
- B. A Personal Paging Service agreement shall be executed prior to the establishment of service.
- C. Personal Paging Service subscribers will not receive a directory listing for the name or receiver number.
- D. Service Connection Charges apply as applicable in Section A4 of this tariff.

A16.2.2 Definitions

- A. Tone Only A class of paging service that alerts the subscriber of a page by a moderately loud "beeping" tone.
- -G.B. Tone & Digital Display A class of paging service that alerts the subscriber of a page by a moderately loud "beeping" tone. The service provides a fixed "on the air" time to allow the calling party to deliver up to a ten-digit display.
