Subject: Postponement of the Final Analysis and Review of Gross-up Petition and Request for Extension to File the 1994 Gross-up report.

We have received your letter dated January 12, 1996, in which you request, on behalf of Parkland Utilities, Inc., that no further action be taken upon its request for permanent gross-up authority, and that the required filing of the 1994 gross-up report be extended until after the Commission has made a final decision on the changes. Having reviewed this request, the utility shall be granted a thirty (30) day extension to file the 1994 gross-up report. The required gross-up report shall now be filed on March 15, 1996. However, staff cannot recommend to the Commission that the utility's request to postpone the review for final authority be granted. If you wish the Commission to consider this request, please file a specific petition making this request. Otherwise, the utility should submit any additional information that it deems relevant toward granting final authority.
