Issue 1: Recommendation that ALLTEL's motion for an extension of time until May 12, 1996, and its motion for an additional extension of time to implement business calls at \$.25 per call instead of BCS rates until October 1, 1996 on the routes identified in staff's February 22, 1996 memoradum should be granted. ALLTEL should provide notice to its affected business customers explaining the interim \$.25 plan, and provide a follow-up notice to these customers prior to the conversion to BCS.

Since BellSouth and United provide the other ends of these routes, extension of time should also be granted for these local exchange companies (LECs) until May 12, 1996 to implement ECS.
