I received the enclosed (undated) notice concerning Forest Utilities application for extension of sewer service. Our company owns a light industrial building in the affected area. The facility is occupied by a small manufacturing company with several employees.

We have never been contacted by Lee County regarding a need for sewers in this area. Forest Industries notice failed to indicate any reason for installing sewers in this area.

It is unreasonable to expect small business owners to pay for the inconvenience of having their property tear up and their customer traffic disrupted without significant justification.

We are opposed to Forest Utilities service area extension. We should not be required to fund an unnecessary service to expand another company's business.
