AMENDATORY ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

By Order No. PSC-96-0446-FOF-TL, issued March 29, 1996, this Commission granted, in part, and denied, in part, a petition by the Independent Directory Publishers to modify certain provisions of BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc.'s (BellSouth's) Directory Publishers Database Service (DPDS) tariff. At the bottom of page 8, and continuing at the top of page 9, we inadvertantly ordered BellSouth to amend its Weekly Business Activity Reports (WBARs) to include residential listings, so that the WBARs could be used as an update service. However, since at page 7 of Order No. PSC-96-0446-FOF-TL, we had already ordered BellSouth to file a tariff to provide an appropriate update service, it is unnecessary to require it to also amend its DPDS tariff to include residential service. Order No. PSC-96-0446-FOF-TL is, therefore, amended to delete the requirement that BellSouth amend its WBARs to include residential listings. The remainder of Order No. PSC-96-0446-FOF-TL is affirmed in all other respects.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Order No. PSC-96-0446-FOF-TL is amended to delete the requirement that BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. modify its Weekly Business Activity Reports to include residential listings. It is further

ORDERED that Order No. PSC-96-0446-FOF-TL is affirmed in all other respects.
