The purpose of this hearing shall be to allow Tampa Electric Company to present its testimony and exhibits concerning the prudence of and appropriate regulatory treatment for Tampa Electric Company's Polk Unit; to permit any intervenors to present testimony and exhibits concerning this matter; and for such other purposes as the Commission may deem appropriate. All witnesses shall be subject to cross-examination at the conclusion of their testimony. The proceedings will be governed by the provisions of Chapter 120, Florida Statutes, and Chapter 25-22, Florida Administrative Code.

A prehearing conference will be conducted at the following time and place:


