Dear Ms. Morrow:

This letter follows our conversation earlier this week regarding the reimbursement of AFPI charges. During the SSU hearing, our office was given a copy of a letter to Mr. Robert Sadler dated February 28, 1995. Apparently Mr. Sadler requested an irrigation meter be installed at property described as 8 Wild Olive Court in the Sugar Mill Woods service area, Citrus County.

By the letter from your office dated February 28, 1995, Mr. Sadler was given an estimated cost for the connection and/or meter installation which included AFPI charges. During our conversation, you indicated that, even though Mr. Sadler was an existing customer, he had never paid any AFPI charges. Further, you indicated that no AFPI charges had been "affiliated with this area" when Mr. Sadler was first connected to the system. However, at the time of his request for the irrigation meter, AFPI charges had been approved for the area, resulting in the inclusion of AFPI charges as part of the estimated cost for connection and/or meter installation.

AFA _____ It is our understanding that Mr. Sadler requested a downgrade from a 1" meter to
APP ~~two~~ 5/8" x 3/4" meters. His purpose was to install a meter which would serve his rental
CAF property and install a separate irrigation meter for lawn maintenance. Since the 1" meter
CMU served 2.5 ERCs and the two 5/8" x 3/4" meters will serve 2.0 ERCs, the downgrade, even
CTR with the addition of a second meter, results in less potential demand on the system.
EAG ~~Therefore~~, a reimbursement of that portion of the estimated cost charged to Mr. Sadler
associated with AFPI charges is appropriate.
