ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE TESTIMONY  
AND  
ORDER REVISING ORDER ESTABLISHING PROCEDURE

On May 13, 1996, the Office of Public Counsel (OPC), filed its Citizens' Motion for Extension of Time to File Testimony. Order No. PSC-96-0577-PCO-WS, issued May 2, 1996, requires the OPC to file its prefiled direct testimony on May 15, 1996.

In its motion, OPC requests an extension of 7 days to file its testimony. Further, OPC represents that it discussed its motion with counsel for Palm Coast Utility Corporation (PCUC), and that PCUC makes no objection to OPC's motion as long as the Commission grants PCUC an additional 7 days within which to file its rebuttal testimony.

OPC's motion is based on the fact that counsel and consultants for this docket were extensively involved in the two-week long Southern States Utilities, Inc., rate case hearing which concluded on May 10, 1996. As a result, OPC requests additional time to file effective and complete testimony.

Upon consideration, I find it appropriate to partially grant OPC's motion. Accordingly, Order No. PSC-96-0577-PCO-WS is revised to the extent set forth below:

NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

The Florida Public Service Commission is required by Section 120.59(4), Florida Statutes, to notify parties of any administrative hearing or judicial review of Commission orders that is available under Sections 120.57 or 120.68, Florida Statutes, as well as the procedures and time limits that apply. This notice should not be construed to mean all requests for an administrative hearing or judicial review will be granted or result in the relief sought.

Any party adversely affected by this order, which is preliminary, procedural or intermediate in nature, may request: (1) reconsideration within 10 days pursuant to Rule 25-22.0376, Florida Administrative Code, if issued by a Prehearing Officer; (2) reconsideration within 15 days pursuant to Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code, if issued by the Commission; or (3) judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court, in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility, or the First District Court of Appeal, in the case of a water or wastewater utility. A motion for reconsideration shall be filed with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting, in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code. Judicial review of a preliminary, procedural or intermediate ruling or order is available if review of the final action will not provide an adequate remedy. Such review may be requested from the appropriate court, as described above, pursuant to Rule 9.100, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
