PETITION AND PROPOSAL OF FLORIDA CABLE TELECOMMUNICATIONS ASSOCIATION, INC. FOR DISPOSITION OF 1996 UNALLOCATED RATE REDUCTIONS

The Florida Cable Telecommunications Association, Inc. ("FCTA"), pursuant to Order No. PSC-94-0172-FOF-TL, respectfully submits its proposal to the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") for disposition of a portion of the 1996 rate reductions scheduled for October 1, 1996 in the above-referenced docket. In support of its proposal FCTA states:

3. FCTA is a party of record in this docket and a signatory to the January 12, 1994

Implementation Agreement for Portions of the Unspecified Rate Reductions in Stipulation and

Agreement Between the Office of Public Counsel and Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph

Company ("Implementation Agreement") approved by Order No. PSC-94-0172-FOF-TL issued February 11, 1994.

- 4. Pursuant to the terms of paragraph 4 of the Implementation Agreement, not less than 120 days prior to October 1, 1996, the parties must submit their proposals for disposition of the \$48 million in unallocated rate reductions authorized under the <u>Stipulation and Agreement Between the Office of Public Counsel and Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company</u> approved by Order No. PSC-94-0172-FOF-TL. The terms of the Implementation Agreement permit FCTA to submit a proposal to the Commission. The current Case Assignment and Scheduling Record (CASR) in this docket identifies June 1, 1996 as the date by which parties are to file their proposals concerning this matter.
- 5. FCTA proposes that a portion of the unallocated \$48 million in 1996 rate reductions should be utilized to completely eliminate non-recurring charges for the interconnection trunks that Alternative Local Exchange Telecommunications Companies (ALECs) order from BellSouth and non-recurring charges for dedicated, switched circuits ALECs order out of the BellSouth Special Access Tariff. Experience in the marketplace has proven that the elimination of these non-recurring charges is necessary to achieve the widespread availability of competitive alternatives for local service.
- 6. FCTA anticipates obtaining from BellSouth information to quantify the revenue impact of this proposal and provide additional information. Accordingly, FCTA reserves the right to modify or supplement this proposal based on the additional information obtained.
- 7. At this time, the Commission has not yet issued a procedural order in this docket, but the CASR schedules dates for testimony and an issue identification conference. FCTA will be fully prepared to further explain and support this proposal through testimony and subsequent proceedings.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, FCTA requests the Commission adopt its petition and proposal for the elimination of non-recurring charges identified herein effective October 1, 1996.
