STAFF ANALYSIS: TLX filed an application with this Commission on April 12, 1996, to offer telecommunications service as a switchless rebiller in Florida.

TLX's exhibit of managerial qualifications (page 3-6) reflects a satisfactory record in telecommunications sales, marketing and service. In regard to technical capability, TLX indicated in their application that the company will be operating as a switchless rebiller and will rely on the network ownership, operation and management of its underlying carrier(s).

The Division of Auditing and Financial Analysis reviewed TLX's financial statement to determine the company's financial viability (pages 7-8). Based on the information provided by TLX, the financial capability of the company appears adequate.
