BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC.'S
REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION
AND MOTION FOR PERMANENT PROTECTIVE ORDER

COMES NOW BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Division Code, and files its Request for Confidential Classification and Motion for Permanent Protective Order for the Company's Response to the requirements contained in Order No. PSC-0445-FOF-TP ("Order") issued on March 29, 1996 in the above captioned docket.

1. BellSouth is filing its Request for Confidential Classification for its responses to the Order because BellSouth deems the information requested to be confidential and proprietary business information. The document reflects details on how to access, enter, and change data in BellSouth's E911 Emergency System. This system must be protected from those who might make inappropriate use of the system. Disclosure of this information would impair the safety and welfare of the community.

2. BellSouth has appended to this Request for Confidential Classification as Attachment A a listing showing the location in the response of the information designated by BellSouth as confidential.

3. Appended hereto in an envelope designated as Attachment B is one copy of the response with the confidential information deleted.

4. Attached as Attachment C is a sealed envelope containing one copy of the response with the material which is confidential and proprietary. Copies of Attachment C are not being served on the other parties in this proceeding.

5. Regarding BellSouth's Response to the Order, this response is entitled to proprietary confidential classification. The document provides details concerning BellSouth's E911 Emergency System. This system is used by the citizens of Florida to notify the appropriate authorities in emergency situations. This document is provided only to those authorized to interface with the E911 Database and only upon execution of a nondisclosure agreement. Public disclosure of this information could jeopardize the safety and welfare of the general public in that unauthorized users could cause havoc with the system, thereby impairing the ability of emergency personnel to cope with emergencies. There are also legitimate concerns regarding safeguarding the privacy of the subscriber listings contained in the system. Section 364.183(c), Florida Statutes, expressly considers as proprietary confidential information any information relating to security systems, measures, or procedures. The information contained in BellSouth's Response to the Order, as more specifically described above, meets the statutory criteria, and should therefore be afforded confidential classification.

6. BellSouth has treated and intends to continue to treat the material for which confidential classification is sought as private, and this information has not been generally disclosed.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, BellSouth moves the Commission to enter an order declaring the information described above and contained in the indicated portions of the attachments to be confidential proprietary business information, and thus not subject to public disclosure.

Explanation for Proprietary Information

E911 Local Exchange Carrier Guide For Facility-Based Providers dated 02/15/96. This document contains proprietary and confidential business information. This Guide provides details on how to access, enter and change data in BellSouth's (BST) E911 Emergency System. This system is used by the citizens of Florida to notify the appropriate authorities (Fire, Medical, or Police) in emergency situations. BellSouth releases copies of this document, only after the execution of a non disclosure agreement, to those who are authorized to interface with the E911 Data Base. This system must be protected from those who might make inappropriate use of the system. This information is valuable, it is used by BellSouth in conducting its business and BellSouth strives to keep it secret. Therefore, such information is a trade secret which should be classified as proprietary, confidential business information pursuant to Section 364.183, Florida Statutes and is exempt from the Open Records Act.
